CHARACTERS

THEME: Witnessing

Sue- The Doorkeeper
Be-Nice and Bible-Head
Mr. Jones

(A door is at center stage. Be-Nice walks on, "Heh heh"-ing as he goes. He walks up to the door and reaches for the handle. Sue runs on and throws herself in front of the door.)

SUE- No!!!!

BE-NICE- Hey! Get outta the way!

SUE- Don't go in there!

BE-NICE- Heh heh. Ummm, why not?

SUE- Because, on the other side of this door is a dark, damp, bottomless pit! You fall in it, and you'll never come out alive!

BE-NICE- Really? Heh heh. Cool. So, like, why don't you put a sign on it or something?

SUE- I can't!

BE-NICE- Why not?

SUE- Because that would make things too simple and there wouldn't be any plot to this sketch. And if there's no plot to the sketch, the audience is gonna get bored. And we don't want that to happen...do we?

BE-NICE- Oh. Heh heh. Okay.

SUE- I'll tell you what we can do. Stand right here, and if anybody comes by, tell them not to go in.

BE-NICE- Hey! Heh heh. Why do I have to do it?

SUE- Because this is your sketch, not mine! Nobody cares what I do. I'm just here for plot exposition.

BE-NICE- Really? Heh heh. I'll be darned.

(Sue runs off. Bible-Head walks on and walks to the door.)

BE-NICE- Freeze, scum bag!

BIBLE-HEAD- Settle down, Be-Nice. It's just me.

BE- NICE- I said Freeze! You can't go in there!

BIBLE-HEAD- Why not?

BE-NICE- Umm, it's like, you know, dangerous 'n' stuff?

BIBLE- HEAD- Really?

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. I'm supposed to stand guard and, like, keep people from falling in.

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. Cool.

(Todd enters.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. Check it out. It's Todd!

TODD- Hey, geeks. Move outta the way. Passin' through!

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhh, I wouldn't go in there if I were you.

TODD- *(threatening)* And why not?

BE-NICE- Uhhh, *(to Be-Nice)* Why don't you tell him?

TODD- Yeah, tell me geek! Is there some reason why I shouldn't go inside this door?

BE-NICE- Ummmm...

TODD- IS there?

BE-NICE- Ummm, not a thing in the world.

TODD- Didn't think so.

(Todd walks through the door. He screams. The scream trails off as if she is falling. Be-Nice and Bible-Head watch his fall. "THUD" sound effect.)

BIBLE-HEAD- That was the coolest thing I have ever seen. Did you see the way he bounced?

BE-NICE- Yeah, yeah! Heh heh. Boi-oi-oi-oi-oi-ing!

(Sue walks on.)

SUE- This message was brought to you by Be-Nice and Bible-Head. If you had some information that could save someone's life, wouldn't you share it with them?

Be-Nice and Bible-Head in...
Be-Nice's Mom

CHARACTERS

Be-Nice and Bible-Head

THEME: Parents

(An overhead projector screen is at up stage center. Be-Nice and Bible-Head roll an overhead projector on to stage center stage, doing their usual laughs. They aim it at the audience.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. That's good. Turn it on.

BE-NICE- Heh heh. Okay.

(Be-Nice turns it on.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. You dummy. You've got it backwards.

BE-NICE- Oh, heh heh. Sorry.

(Be-Nice turns the projector around so it hits the screen.)

BIBLE-HEAD- There. That's good.

(Bible-Head walks to down stage right. Be-Nice begins making shadow puppets.)

BE-NICE- Hey, Bible-Head, heh heh, check it out! It's a dog!

BIBLE-HEAD- Knock it off, or I'm not gonna help you. Put up the first picture.

BE-NICE- Heh heh. Okay.

(Be-Nice puts up an overhead that says "My Parins")

BIBLE-HEAD- Okay. Be-Nice asked me to help him with his presentation today, "My Parents." So, huh huh, here it is. *(to Be-Nice)* Put up the next one.

(Be-Nice puts up the next slide. It is a stick drawing of Be-Nice's mom.)

BIBLE-HEAD- This is Be-Nice's mom. She's old. Huh huh. She like, dated Abraham Lincoln.

BE-NICE- Shut up! She's not that old! Heh heh. She dated his cousin.

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhh, oh yeah. Huh huh. She's got, like, some fake color hair, she always makes Be-Nice clean his room, and she won't let us beat up his cat.

BE-NICE- Yeah, yeah, heh heh. I hate cats.

BIBLE-HEAD- Go to the next picture.

BE-NICE- Heh heh. Okay.

(Next picture. A stick man sitting in a recliner.)

BIBLE-HEAD- And this is Be-Nice's dad. He works all day, and then comes home and sits in his chair and watches 60 Minutes.

BE-NICE- Yeah, yeah. And it has that guy, you know? *(does Andy Rooney)* Why is it that you park in a drive way and drive in a park way? Heh heh. Cool, yeah.

BIBLE-HEAD- He usually goes to sleep, but whenever we, like, try to change the channel, he wakes up and yells at us.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. He gets real mad when we, like, turn on videos. Even the good ones with FIRE!

BIBLE-HEAD- And they never let us do cool things like build bombs or take hostages.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. Like, one time we took Stewart hostage--

BIBLE-HEAD- Show them the slide, Be-Nice.

BE-NICE- Oh yeah.

(Next picture. A fat stick man.)

BE-NICE- Heh heh. Stewart's fat.

BIBLE-HEAD- But when we, like, tied him up in the basement, they grounded us for, like, a month.

BE-NICE- Yeah. Heh heh. They, like, oppressed us or something.

BIBLE-HEAD- So we, like, decided to, you know, "take care of 'em."

BE-NICE- Yeah. We were gonna dig a pit, and fill it full of spiders, and snakes, and those guys from those music videos who beat people up and--

BIBLE-HEAD- Show them the picture, dude.

BE-NICE- Oh, heh heh. Right.

(Next picture. A pit with spiders, snakes, rock videos guys, etc.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Yeah, huh huh. We were gonna make them pay. But then we remembered something. Like, if we did them in, Be-Nice's dad couldn't teach us cool things like crushing cans on his forehead.

BE-NICE- And they couldn't, like, drop us off at the mall 'n' stuff.

BIBLE-HEAD- And Be-Nice's mom couldn't make any more of those pigs in a blanket.

BE-NICE- Heh heh. You know what hot dogs are made of? Heh heh. Lips, and fannies!

(Next picture. Picture of a pig with arrows pointing to the lips and tail.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Be-Nice, you heathen, you can't say fannies in church.

BE-NICE- Heh heh. Oh yeah. Heh heh. Lips and tushies.

BIBLE-HEAD- So we decided to let them live, because even though they ground us and stuff, Be-Nice loves his mommy and daddy.

(Next picture. A heart.)

BE-NICE- Heh heh. What can I say? Heh heh. I'm a sensitive guy, you know?

BIBLE-HEAD- And that's the story of Be-Nice's parents.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. Let's get out of here. My mom's still got some pudding left in

the refrigerator from last Christmas.
BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. Mold is cool.

(They exit. Blackout.)

Be-Nice and Bible-Head in...

Todd Is Cool

CHARACTERS

Be-Nice and Bible-Head
Todd- A Tough Guy
FBI SWAT Team

THEME: Peer Pressure

(Todd is at center stage, dressed in jeans, a t-shirt with a pack of cigarettes rolled up in his sleeve, boots, and sunglasses. He has a toothpick in his mouth. Be-Nice and Bible-Head enter. They see Todd and freeze.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Whoa! Huh huh! Check it out, Be-Nice. It's Todd!

BE-NICE- Yeah, yeah! Heh heh! Todd's cool! Heh heh.

BIBLE-HEAD- Come on! This may be our chance.

BE-NICE- Yeah. Heh heh. What chance?

BIBLE-HEAD- To hang out with Todd.

BE-NICE- Oh, yeah, heh heh.

(Be-Nice and Bible-Head walk up to Todd, both doing their trademark laugh. Todd turns to look at them.)

TODD- You fellas got a starin' problem?

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh! Todd spoke to us!

BE-NICE- Yeah, yeah, heh heh. Talk again!

TODD- I said you boys got a STARIN' PROBLEM?

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhhhhhh, no.

TODD- Then what are you doin' here?

BE-NICE- Ummm, we just wanna, you know, hang out?

BIBLE-HEAD- Yeah. Can we...roll with your homies?

TODD- *(laughs)* You boys want to hang out with me?

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. I am your biggest fan.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. Me too!

TODD- Okay. But first, you gotta show you're loyal to me. You'll both have to pay the ten dollar membership fee.

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhhh, membership fee?

TODD- Well you can't hang out with me for free!

(Be-Nice and Bible-Head dig in their pockets for money.)

BE-NICE- I got a quarter.

BIBLE-HEAD- I've got a Bazooka Joe gum wrapper.

TODD- Eh! You guys can pay me the next time. Now, you gotta look like me. Roll your cigarettes up in your sleeve, like this.

BE-NICE- Ummm, we don't have, like, any cigarettes.

TODD- You don't have any cigarettes?

BIBLE-HEAD- I gotta pack of Juicy Fruit.

TODD- *(sighs)* Well, I guess that'll do. But if it falls out around me, I'll kill ya! Now, the ultimate test!

(Todd exits.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. Todd is cool.

BE-NICE- Yeah! Heh heh. We're gonna hang with him!

(Todd enters with a pillow.)

TODD- Here. *(hands Bible-Head the pillow)* See the tag on that pillow?

BIBLE-HEAD- *(reading)* Uhhh, "Doh...not...reee-mov....under....pen-all-tee...of...law."

"Do not remove under penalty of law"?

TODD- Rip it off!

BIBLE-HEAD- You want us to break the law?

TODD- You're not afraid, are ya?

BE-NICE- No way! Heh heh! Let me do it!

(Be-Nice rips the tag off. Todd exits. Sirens wail. The SWAT Team runs on, machine guns drawn. They throw Be-Nice and Bible-Head to the ground. One man puts his foot in Be-Nice's back and aims his gun directly at his head. Another does the same with Bible-Head.)

SWAT- FREEZE!!!!!!!!!!

BE-NICE- Owwww! You're crushing my back!

BIBLE-HEAD- This is the coolest thing that has ever happened to us.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. Todd is cool.

Be-Nice and Bible-Head in...
Valentines Day

CHARACTERS

THEME: Valentine's Day

Be-Nice and Bible-Head
 Alyssa, Amanda, Aimee, Ashlee- Cute Chicks
 Biff- Ashlee's boyfriend
 Drearia- A sardonic, morose teenager

(Be-Nice and Bible-Head enter, doing their usual laugh.)

BE-NICE- Hey, heh heh, Bible-Head, what are we doing here?
 BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhh, we're trying to get dates to the Valentine's dance, remember?
 BE-NICE- Oh, heh heh. But isn't the dance going on already?
 BIBLE-HEAD- That's why we're out here, doofus. We grab the first two chicks who
 come by and make them be our dates.
 BE-NICE- Oh, heh heh, okay.

(Bible-Head pulls out some binaca and sprays it in his mouth.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Here, dude. Try some of this.
 BE-NICE- Heh heh. Okay.

(Be-Nice sprays himself in the eyes.)

BE-NICE- AAAHHHHHHHHHHHH!!!!!!!
 BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh, huh huh! You dork!
 BE-NICE- I can't see! Bible-Head, I can't see!
 BIBLE-HEAD- Shhh! I think I see a couple of chicks!

(Alyssa and Amanda enter.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Uh, Hey...baby. Wanna go to the dance with me?
 BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. Me too.
 ALYSSA- Why in the world would we go to the dance with you?
 BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhh, I got spearminty fresh breath.
 BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. Darn, we're smooth!

(Alyssa and Amanda exit the other way to the dance.)

BE-NICE- Heh heh. They're getting away!
 BIBLE-HEAD- Relax, Be-Nice. here comes another one.

(Aimee enters.)

BE-NICE- Check it out, heh heh! It's Aimee!

BIBLE-HEAD- Come to Bible-Head.

AIMEE- What are you boys doing here?

BIBLE-HEAD- Hey...baby. Huh huh. Wanna go to a dance?

AIMEE- You mean...with YOU? Ha! I wouldn't dance with you if you were the last man on earth!

BE-NICE- Heh heh. If I was the mast man on earth, you wouldn't be allowed in line?

(Aimee slaps Be-Nice then exits toward the dance. Drearia enters.)

BE-NICE- Owwww!

BIBLE-HEAD- Dude, what did you tell her that for?

BE-NICE- Heh heh. I'd rather dance with that chick from No Doubt!

DREARIA- What in the world are you guys doing here? You're not seriously trying to get dates, are you?

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhh, why?

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. What's wrong with that? Heh heh. Diarrhea.

DREARIA- The name is Drearia, and you guys don't need dates.

BE-NICE- But it's Valentine's Day, heh heh!

BIBLE-HEAD- Yeah, huh huh. I'm ready for love.

DREARIA- You don't need a girlfriend or a date to feel loved. You already have the love of God. What more could you want?

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhhhhh, oh yeah. We don't need dates. We've got God. Huh huh. Come on. Let's get out of here.

BE-NICE- What? Heh heh. No way! No way I'm leaving without a date, heh heh!

(Be-Nice breaks into passionate monologue. Biff and Ashlee enter, holding hands.)

BE-NICE- I've been waiting all my life, heh heh, dreaming of the day I'd meet Cindy Crawford, or that chick from No Doubt, or the chick from the *X-Files*, or the Pink Ranger chick! But I never do! I never get dates! I never get love! I can't even get the fat chick in US History to talk to me. She just yanks my underwear over my head and walks away, heh heh! *(points to Biff)* Look at this guy, heh heh. I bet he gets lots of dates! *(points to Ashlee)* And this chick, heh heh! I never see her when she's not with a guy! But she's never with me, heh heh! Why won't she go out with me, heh heh? Why? Why? WHY?!?!?!?!?

(Biff punches Be-Nice, who flops to the ground.)

BIFF- 'Cause she's goin' with me, Nimrod!

(Biff and Ashlee exit to the dance. Be-Nice sits up, holding his nose.)

BE-NICE- You're right, heh heh. God loves me.

DREARIA- Come on, guys. We'll go to a movie or something.

(Bible-Head and Drearia help Be-Nice stand up. The three begin to walk off stage away from the dance.)

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. You wuss. He, like, totally, beat you up.

BE-NICE- Heh heh, No he didn't! Heh heh. I let him get away.

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. He broke your face.

BE-NICE- No he didn't, heh heh. It's collapsible, heh heh. You know, like the cups?

(Exit. Blackout.)

Be-Nice and Bible-Head in...

The Legend of GOSPOLIO!

CHARACTERS

THEME: School

Be-Nice- Christian who's alter ego is Gospolio

Bible-Head- Be-Nice's friend

Coach- Health teacher

Radia- A low-key, droll, "everyone else is an idiot" type girl

Kelly- A cool chick

Joe- Another guy in class

(School bell rings. Lights up. There is a chalkboard at stage right. Coach is in front of the chalkboard. The students are seated from stage right to left: Radia, Be-Nice, Bible-Head, Kelly, and Joe. Be-Nice and Bible-Head "Heh-heh" and "Huh-huh" from the opening lights up.)

COACH- Good morning, class. Today, we will take a look at the circulatory system. As you will know from the reading, the circulatory system is responsible for the distribution of blood to the body. It is composed of a network of veins, arteries, and capillaries which carry blood to and from the central organ the heart.

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. The heart.

COACH- Yes, the heart. The heart pumps the blood through the various channels and distributes it throughout the body.

BIBLE-HEAD- *(to Kelly)* Hey, baby. Do you have Jesus in your heart?

COACH- Inside the blood are red and white cells. The red cells carry oxygen to the cells in the body, and the white cells are there to ward off infection.

BIBLE-HEAD- Come to Jesus. Jesus loves you.

COACH- Excuse me, Mr. Bible-Head, do you have something to add to this discussion?

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhhhh...God rocks.

BE-NICE- Heh heh. Yeah, yeah. All the time!

COACH- Do I hear you correctly? Are you trying to evangelize on my time?

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhh, no.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. We're Christians. We don't, you know, do that kind of thing.

COACH- Then what do you call what I just heard?

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhhh, witnessing?

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh! I saw him do it! I witnessed the whole thing!

COACH- Do you boys realize it is illegal to talk about God on school grounds?

BIBLE-HEAD- Huh huh. Really?

RADIA- It is not illegal. It's only illegal if you teach it to us.

BIBLE- I didn't ask you, you manic depressive!

RADIA- They have just as much of a right to share their faith as anyone else.

COACH- Maybe by the law of the land, but not in this classroom!

BE-NICE- Hey! Are you threatening me? Heh-heh! Are you censoring me?

(Be-Nice begins to go into spasms, shaking his head and arms.)

COACH- What in the wide wide world of sports is the matter with you son?

(Be-Nice pulls his T-shirt over his head so only his face shows. He stands, holds his arms up like a referee signalling a field goal, and begins marching back and forth on stage.)

BE-NICE- You cannot threaten me! I am the great Gospolio! I share the Gospel with my testimonio! Heh heh! Testimonio about *Jesu Christo!* Heh heh!

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhh, looks like he's, you know, in the spirit.

BE-NICE- Yeah, yeah! Spirit Holio! Holio Spirito! Heh heh!

COACH- I don't care what he's on! Snap him out of it!

BE-NICE- You cannot threaten me! My God is bigger than you! He maketh me share my testimonio!

RADIA- He has a right to share his faith, no matter what he believes.

BE-NICE- I believe in *Jesu*, heh heh. *Jesu Christo!*

COACH- All right! All right, then! But please, will you do it after class?

(Be-Nice stops marching.)

BE-NICE- Ummmm, okay.

(Be-Nice puts his shirt on correctly and sits down.)

COACH- Now that that incident is over, we can go on.

(Fire alarm rings.)

COACH- That's it people! Fire drill! Move out in single file line!

(Coach exits, followed by Joe and Radia. Kelly is next in line, followed by Be-Nice and Bible-Head. Kelly turns to the other two.)

KELLY- Hey, I don't know what you were on just then, but I'd love to try it. Do you know where I can get some?

BIBLE-HEAD- Uhhhhh, sure, huh huh. *(puts his arm around her)* So like, you ever considered going to church?

(Be-Nice switches back into Gospolio mode. Bible-Head and Kelly exit as Be-Nice yells out to the audience...)

BE-NICE- People of high school, listen to me! I am Gospolio! Jesus loves you! Give him your heartio! Heh, heh! *(looks at diagram of circulatory system, then exits, saying)* Cardio! Cardio pulmonario! Give *Jesu Christo* your cardio part-io!

Be-Nice

THEME: Becoming a Christian

(Lights out. Be-Nice and Bible-Head are heard laughing. Lights slowly come up on the two sitting on their couch. Throughout the skit, they continue to "huh huh" and "heh heh".)

BE-NICE- Uh, hi.

BIBLE- Uhhh, yeah. Like, how's it going or something?

(Pause.)

BE-NICE- Ummmm, so like, what are we doing here?

BIBLE- Uh, I don't remember.

BE-NICE- Maybe we should like introduce ourselves or something.

BIBLE- Uhhhh, okay. *(to audience)* I'm Bible-Head and this is Be-Nice, and, uhhh...

BE-NICE- Heh heh. We're a Band!

BIBLE- Huh huh. Yeah. That would be cool!

BE-NICE- Heh heh. Yeah. Now what?

BIBLE- Uhhhh, oh, I remember! We're supposed to like give our testimony.

BE-NICE- Oh, yeah, heh heh. Cool. I'll go first. *(yells)* He did it! I saw him do it! He killed them all, heh heh!

BIBLE- Shut up, you nit wit! Not that kind of testimony. We're supposed to talk about how, like, we became Christians and stuff.

BE-NICE- Oh yeah. Heh heh. I knew that. *(pause)* Ummm, I, like, used to be into drugs and sports and stuff, but, I'm not any more because--

(Bible-Head smacks Be-Nice.)

BE-NICE- Oww!

BIBLE- They want our story, not the guy who came to church last week.

BE-NICE- Oh, heh heh. But his was so cool and all.

(Bible-Head smacks Be-Nice again.)

BE-NICE- Oww!

BIBLE- Okay, so like, a long time ago, me and Be-Nice thought we had it all. We, like, worked at Burger World, ate all the nachos we wanted to, and watched TV all day.

BE-NICE- Yeah, TV rules!

BIBLE- No, God rules!

BE-NICE- Heh heh. *(cheers)* All the time! All the time, God rules!

BIBLE- Let me finish the story. Okay, so we, like, had it pretty good. We thought life just didn't get any better than that. Then one day, we heard about Jesus.

BE-NICE- Yeah. We'd like always heard his name in, like, all those rated R movies where people are like cussing and stuff.

BIBLE- Huh huh. Yeah. But we, like, had know idea he was the son of God.

BE-NICE- Heh heh, yeah. That's pretty cool!

BIBLE- He's like the ruler of the universe, and he's the most powerful dude in the whole wide world.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. Jesus rules!

BIBLE- Yeah. And Jesus is, like, not only strong, but he's perfect. And because he was perfect, he couldn't, like, hang out with guys like us.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. He couldn't hang with us 'cause we're, like, not perfect, you know?

BIBLE- And for everybody who wasn't perfect, there was only one place to go.

BE-NICE- Yeah, yeah, heh heh. School.

BIBLE- Nope. Hell.

BE-NICE- Aaaaaaaaahhhhh! No way!

BIBLE- Relax, Be-Nice, we don't have to go to Hell.

BE-NICE- Oh yeah, heh heh. *(pause)* Why not?

BIBLE- Because Jesus died for our sins so that we wouldn't have to go to Hell.

BE-NICE- Oh yeah! That was pretty cool. But isn't he, like, alive now?

BIBLE- Uhhh, yeah. Jesus died for our sins, then he rose from the dead.

BE-NICE- Yeeeeeeesssssss! That's really cool!

BIBLE- And all we had to do was believe in him and we could live forever in Heaven with Jesus.

BE-NICE- Yeah, heh heh. Heaven is cool.

BIBLE- So that night, Be-Nice and I asked Jesus to come into our hearts.

BE-NICE- Yeah. *(knocks on his chest)* Heh heh. How's it goin' in there?

BIBLE- Now, at last, we had everything. We knew life couldn't get any better.

BE-NICE- Heh heh. But it did.

BIBLE- Oh, yeah. The chicks next door found out we had become Christians, so they asked us to do a Bible study with them.

(Chicks with Bibles enter, sit on and around the couch with Be-Nice and Bible-Head.)

CHICK1- Hello, boys.

CHICK2- We're ready to start our Bible study.

BIBLE- *(to Be-nice)* You know, dude, it just doesn't get any better than this.

(Play "something cool" by some cool Christian band. Be-nice and Bible-Head sing along and air guitar to the music. Lights fade out.)
