THREE CHEERS FOR MORBIDMAN

SCENE ONE

NARR- This is the city. Terminus City, home of the world's greatest university. Home to the world champion co-ed lacrosse team, the Terminus City Wombats. And home to those great super heroes - at least in their own minds - Morbidman, Everyman, and Master of the Obvious!

(Morbidman, Everyman, and Master of the Obvious enter.)

MORBIDMAN- Smell that boys?

EVERYMAN- Yeah, what is that funky smell.

MASTER- Most likely, the smell of molten rubber from the rubber doggie poo plant.

MORBIDMAN- No, my friends. That is the smell of a crime-free city.

NARR- Yes, the streets of Terminus City have been quiet for months now. Six months to be exact. But much as our heroes would like to think themselves responsible, they are not.

(Dr. Insidious enters, carrying groceries.)

EVERYMAN- Morbidman! Heinous villain at ten o'clock!

MORBIDMAN- It's Dr. Insidious!

DR. I- Hello, Morbidman.

MORBIDMAN- And just where do you think you're going with that bag?

DR. I- I'm headed home, O Morose One. Is that all right?

MORBIDMAN- Not until we give that bag a thorough inspection!

(Morbidman, Everyman, and Master of the Obvious steal the grocery bags.)

DR. I- Hey! Those are my groceries! I have receipts, I promise!

MORBIDMAN- A ha! Pickles! Lime Jell-O.

EVERYMAN- Cheez-It crackers, Gatorade.

MASTER- Donuts, and a copy of *Modern Baby*.

MORBIDMAN- What kind of twisted mind would have such a grocery list?

DR. I- A pregnant one, you morons!

EVERYMAN- You're pregnant??

MORBIDMAN- What kind of foul plot is this?

DR. I- Master of the Obvious, would you be so kind as to set the record straight.

MASTER- He's not pregnant. His wife is.

DR. I- Don't you remember? The end of our second full-length play, *Morbidman Returns*? It was revealed the Mrs. and I are expecting.

EVERYMAN- Is he right?

MORBIDMAN- I don't remember. We'll have to check out scripts in the Morbidcave.

Meanwhile, we don't have enough evidence to hold him. We'll let you go on your way, Dr. Insidious.

DR. I- Most generous of you, Morbidfellow. The least you can do for a man who hasn't come up with a decent plot for taking over the world in four months. It's not easy with a pregnant wife. I can't imagine how it will be when the baby arrives.

MASTER- It will be worse.

DR. I- That's the fear. Ta ta.

(Dr. Insidious exits.)

MORBIDMAN- That's all this city needs. A second generation of Insidious minds.

MASTER- It could be worse. There could be a second generation Morbidman on the way.

MORBIDMAN- I'll pretend I didn't hear that.

(Morbidman, Everyman, and Master of the Obvious exit.)

NARR- It was getting close to fall, and time once again for school to start up. The Terminus Central High School football team had been practicing for weeks, and the day came for the cheerleaders to do the same.

SCENE TWO

(Christina, Andi, Mandi, Candi, Sandi, and Brandi enter.)

SANDI- Hi, Mandi!

MANDI- Hi Sandi! Hi Candi!

CANDI- Hi Mandi! Hi Brandi!

BRANDI- Hi Candi! Hi Sandi!

SANDI- Hi Brandi! Hi Andi!

ANDI- Hi Sandi! Hi Christina!

CHRISTINA- Hi, girls!

CANDI- How was your summer?

CHRISTINA- Oh, just hung around town enjoying the nice weather.

MANDI- Hasn't it been great?

SANDI- Yes, but I totally can't wait for school to start. I have been so bored!

BRANDI- It all begins here, the first day of cheerleading camp.

ANDI- So where is our beloved coach?

(Kathy enters, six months pregnant.)

KATHY- Hello girls! How is everyone?

CHRISTINA- It's Mrs. Insidious!

CANDI- And she's gotten fat!

NARR- Yes, it was the wife of that notorious villain, Dr. Insidious, and she was not fat but--

KATHY- Six months pregnant, girls.

MANDI- You're having a baby? That's wonderful!

SANDI- Yeah. But how are you gonna coach us with a kid on the way?

BRANDI- Are you kidding? This is Mrs. Insidious! She could out-tumble all of us with 100 pound weighs strapped to her back.

KATHY- Well, that's sweet of you to say, Brandi. But unfortunately, the doctor has ordered me to stay sidelined.

CHRISTINA- You're not going to listen to that evil villain of a husband of yours, are you?

KATHY- Of course not. If I listened to him, I'd be out here with you all instead of him.

CHRISTINA- Dr. Insidious?? Here?

(Dr. Insidious enters, blows a whistle.)

DR. I- All right, maggots!! Fall in for inspection!!

ANDI- Maggots? Hello!!! Terminus Heights is the Maggots! Terminus Central is the-- ready girls?

GIRLS- *(cheering)* We are the platypi! The mighty mighty platypi! Fight! Fight! Fight! Fight! Goooooooooo Platypi!!!

(Dr. Insidious turns to leave. Kathy stops him.)

KATHY- Now, Don, you promised.

DR. I- I can't handle it.

KATHY- Are you telling me my fearsome, wittle dictator's afraid of some girls?

DR. I- Will it get me out of this assignment?

KATHY- Aww, I think our newcomer here needs a little spirit. And how do we pass that spirit along?

(The girls, except Christina, rush over and hug Dr. Insidious. Kathy hugs him too.)

DR. I- Kathy... they're touching me.

KATHY- Okay, girls, tumbling exercises. Go!

(The girls all exit. NOTE: If your actresses can tumble, have them do tumbling back and forth across the stage. If not, have Dr. Insidious pretend to watch them.)

KATHY- That's it, girls! Keep those spins tight! Nice job!

DR. I- Wow, they're really good, aren't they?

KATHY- City champs the last twenty years.

DR. I- These same girls? What, did they flunk every year the last two decades?

KATHY- No, silly. They've just been that well trained since the days when I was a teen.

DR. I- I see.

KATHY- Honestly, Donnie, this won't be that tough of a job. These girls are all veterans, and they can practically run the squad themselves.

DR. I- Maybe I should have brought a book.

KATHY- Oh you silly. Have fun.

(Kathy exits.)

DR. I- All right, girls. Keep those spins spinning and don't tumble when you tumble. Boy, Kathy was right. These girls are good. Very good. They're fast, strong, athletic, and...

NARR- And suddenly, for the first time in months, an evil plan began to form in his mind.

DR. I- What a fool I've been. All this time, relying on henchmen and college interns to do my bidding. Then all of a sudden, I stumble upon a well-trained, fully prepared execution force, ready to do my bidding, and help me take over the world!!!

(Sandi enters.)

SANDI- Do you always talk to yourself in the voice of a maniacal madman? Weirdo.

DR. I- Ladies! Ladies, line up, please.

(The cheerleaders enter and line up.)

DR. I- Okay, nice job everyone. Nice job. Now, tell me, being new here, what sort of things do you cheerleaders do?

MANDI- Well, we cheer at all the football games, of course.

DR. I- Really? Big crowds?

ANDI- Well duh! We're only the best team in the city.

DR. I- Excellent. What else?

BRANDI- Well, we do fund raisers.

DR. I- No kidding, fund raisers. What kind of fund raisers are we talking about?

CANDI- Fun stuff, like car washes and raffles.

DR. I- Make a lot of bank, do we?

BRANDI- You betcha we do! We made over \$1200 at one car wash last year.

DR. I- Oh this is like a dream come true!

CHRISTINA- Just why are you so excited about a fund raiser anyway?

DR. I- What's it to you?

CHRISTINA- I'm the captain of the squad. I'd like to know.

DR. I- Well, I'm the coach. I outrank you.

CHRISTINA- You wouldn't think of using this cheerleading squad for evil, would you?

DR. I- Why, Christina! How could you think such a thing? I can't believe you would... you know what? You have so little faith in me, I don't think this is going to work out. You're cut!

CHRISTINA- Cut? You can't cut me!!

DR. I- Oh yes I can. I just did. Bye bye, take it out of here. Clean out your locker or something.

(Christina exits.)

DR. I- Anyone else want to argue with me and doom yourself to a school year without popularity?

MANDI- No way!

DR. I- Very well. Then we start with my evil plan at phase one: next Saturday, car wash at McDonalds, where we'll raise the money to finance the next step in the plan.

BRANDI- What plan?

DR. I- My latest and greatest plan for taking over the world!!

(Dr. Insidious and the girls exit.)

NARR- Yes, Dr. Insidious had a plan, but already there was a hitch: the girl he cut was no ordinary girl, but the city's one true super hero, the all-American teen known as the Supreme Diva!

SCENE THREE

(Scorn enters with Allie.)

SCORN- Okay, now one last time. Are you going to sign the city over to me, or am I going to have to get cruel with you?

NARR- Now, this of course is not the Supreme Diva, but the city's vigilante third corner in the super hero/villain triangle, the sworn enemy of Morbidman and Dr. Insidious, Scorn!!

SCORN- Thanks, I think they could figure that out, considering I'm not a cutesy little teen with bright colors and Bath and Body Works perfume. Now, Madam Mayor-

ALLIE- I tell you, I'm not the Mayor.

SCORN- Oh right. You look like her, wear your hair like her...

ALLIE- I'm not her!! Look, I've told you, she's my identical sister.

SCORN- Not believing you. Prepare to suffer.

(Scorn puts headphones on Allie attached to a CD player. She presses play. Kenny G music plays. Allie screams in pain. After a few seconds, Scorn presses stop.)

SCORN- Now?

ALLIE- I'm not the Mayor... please stop hurting me.

(Christina enters as the Supreme Diva.)

DIVA- You heard her, Scorn! Let her go!

SCORN- Well, well, the Supreme Diva! You're too late. The mayor's about to surrender to me.

DIVA- That's not the mayor, Scorn. That's her sister. Now let her go, and let's duke it out, you and me.

(Scorn lets Allie go.)

SCORN- All right, little girl, you asked for it.

DIVA- Uh huh, whatever. Let's go.

SCORN- Are you feeling okay?
DIVA- Huh?
SCORN- I don't know, I'm getting a weird vibe, like you're not feeling well.
DIVA- I'm fine.
SCORN- Come on, I've known you long enough I know when you're not well. What's up?
DIVA- I got cut from the cheerleading squad at school today.
SCORN- No!
DIVA- Yeah, can you believe it?
SCORN- With your athleticism, and tumbling skills, you got cut? What idiot cut you?
DIVA- The biggest one in town.
SCORN- Morbidman??
DIVA- Make that the second biggest idiot.
SCORN- Dr. Insidious?
DIVA- Yeah.
SCORN- (*laughing*) He's a cheerleading coach?
DIVA- Well for now. Kathy's having a baby you know.
SCORN- I did hear that, yeah. Wow, what a blow.
DIVA- I can't help thinking he's up to something. Maybe that's why he cut me.
SCORN- Or maybe you're just jealous.
DIVA- What? I'm not jealous.
SCORN- Come on, you mean to tell me this isn't a blow to the super ego?
DIVA- No! Not at all. I'm fine being a non-cheerleader. I can focus more on school work, and crime fighting, and...
SCORN- There, there now. Look, let's both keep our eyes open. But keep an open mind.
DIVA- You think Dr. Insidious really wants to run a cheerleading squad honestly?
SCORN- Sure. It's just the kind of dumb thing he'd be good at. Now come on, I'll buy you an ice cream sundae.

(Scorn and the Diva exit.)

NARR- Saturday arrived, and the cheerleaders set up in the McDonalds parking lot. Dr. Insidious could not have been more excited for the financial windfall that came his way.

SCENE FOUR

(Dr. Insidious enters, counting a wad of cash.)

DR. I- Six thousand dollars in two hours. This is amazing. These girls are amazing. They're like a gift from Heaven. (*looks up to heaven*) I mean I know evil is not your bag, but I really appreciate your not zapping me for turning a cheerleading squad evil. So far.

(Kathy enters.)

KATHY- Hi, Donny.

DR. I- Hello, my pet.

KATHY- How goes the wash?

DR. I- Splendid. We are making big bucks, my darling.

KATHY- Oh, I am so glad to see you having fun. I knew you would enjoy this once you got into it.

DR. I- Am I ever. This is the greatest evil scheme I have ever had.

KATHY- Evil scheme?

DR. I- Yes, err, plan. You know, it's the latest teen slang. Evil scheme, it means a good time, a hootenanny.

(Candi enters.)

CANDI- Here's some more money, Dr. I.

DR. I- Thanks, Candi.

KATHY- Hi, Candi. Looks like you're having a great evil scheme too.

CANDI- Who told you? We were only following orders! It wasn't my idea!

DR. I- Ahem, Candi, I was just telling Kathy that "evil scheme" is the latest slang for having a good time?

CANDI- It is? Oh right, it is! Like in that Freddy Prinze movie. Right.

(Candi exits.)

KATHY- Well, you have a good time, dear. Don't eat too many McNuggets. I'm making steak and shrimp tonight.

DR. I- Baby, you're the greatest.

(Kathy exits. Morbidman, Everyman, and Master of the Obvious enter. Brandi enters.)

BRANDI- Hi, Mister! Want a car wash?

MORBIDMAN- Sorry, kid, I have no money.

MASTER- Yes you do. You're a billionaire.

MORBIDMAN- I'm going to leave you home next time I go out for fast food. Okay, kid, wash, no wax. It's the black one over there with the wings and bazookas. Careful you don't get the machine guns wet.

BRANDI- That'll be a hundred bucks.

MORBIDMAN- A hundred??? Who charges a hundred for a car wash?

DR. I- I do.

EVERYMAN- That voice sounds familiar.

DR. I- Morning, my heroic acquaintances.

MASTER- It's Dr. Insidious!

MORBIDMAN- What are you doing here?

DR. I- Holding a car wash, Morbidman, and yourself?

MASTER- We came out for Sausage McMuffins 'cause someone caused a fire in the kitchen last night.

EVERYMAN- There should have been a warning on the box, "Do not microwave!"

MORBIDMAN- So, you're here with the cheerleaders?

DR. I- Yes.

EVERYMAN- Why?

BRANDI- He's our new coach.

(Morbidman, Everyman, and Master of the Obvious all laugh.)

MORBIDMAN- No really, what's the square doing here?

BRANDI- No really, he is our new coach!

DR. I- That's right, Morbidman.

EVERYMAN- I don't believe it.

DR. I- Kathy's pregnant. Someone had to fill in.

MORBIDMAN- Really? So what's it like, coaching cheerleaders?

DR. I- It's not so bad. We practice, wash cars, cheer at games, and soon we'll be taking over the world.

MORBIDMAN- Right. Like we're going to fall for that line. Come on, guys.

BRANDI- Ahem!

MORBIDMAN- Right. *(pulls out some money)* Here, keep the change.

(Morbidman, Everyman, and Master of the Obvious exit.)

DR. I- Five hundred. I knew we could count on that idiot to contribute to the end of the world.

(Dr. Insidious and Brandi exit.)

NARR- Yes, the car wash was a raging success, and the next day, Dr. Insidious not only had enough money to buy a new secret weapon, but cute new uniforms for the squad. The following Monday, Christina, that's the Supreme Diva, decided to do some checking up on her friends.

SCENE FIVE

(The cheerleaders enter.)

SANDI- So, is everyone, like totally excited about our new uniforms?

MANDI- Of course! We're going to look so good at the game Friday.

CANDI- Yes! Cheerleading, football, and the first step to taking over the world!

BRANDI- Shhh! You know we're not supposed to talk about that.

CANDI- Sorry, it's just so exciting. I mean, like, how many cheerleading squads get to take over the world?

ANDI- Just one that I know of.

BRANDI- This is so cool. It's like working for James Bond, except we're working for the bad guy who James Bond is fighting.

CANDI- Oh my goodness, you're so right. We're like his tough girl army.

SANDI- I sure hope James Bond doesn't show up to stop us.

MANDI- I wouldn't worry. There's no one who can stop us.

(Christina enters.)

CHRISTINA- Hi, girls.

SANDI- Well, well, look who it is.

BRANDI- Do we know her?

CANDI- I think she wanted to be a cheerleader once.

MANDI- But she was too good to stick around and take orders.

CHRISTINA- How have you been? The car wash go well?

ANDI- Aww, I think she wants to talk to us.

CHRISTINA- Candi, stop that. It's me, Christina!

BRANDI- Christina, that's right. Now I remember the name.

CHRISTINA- What's happened to you all?

SANDI- Oh nothing. Just that we've become ten times better without you.

BRANDI- And we're having an evil scheme without you.

CHRISTINA- Evil scheme?

SANDI- Uh yeah. It means good time?

BRANDI- If you were still cool you'd know that.

CHRISTINA- How can you all do this? We're friends, the five of us. Remember nationals last year? Going to New York? And the sleepovers we had this summer!

MANDI- I see her mouth moving, but I'm not catching a word.

SANDI- So sad. She's obviously in loser denial.

CHRISTINA- I can't believe you. I get cut from the squad, and you all turn on me?

CANDI- Hey, you chose your own path.

BRANDI- We were all there.

MANDI- You could have stayed and been a part.

CHRISTINA- No I couldn't. Dr. Insidious is a bad man. He only wants to use you to help him take over the world?

ANDI- N-no he doesn't.

BRANDI- Besides, maybe we want to take over the world too.

(Mandi hit Brandi on the arm.)

CHRISTINA- I knew it! Okay, girls, you want to take over the world? Try it. I will be there to stop you. Just wait.

(Christina exits.)

CANDI- Loser. All right, let's get to practice.

SANDI- Give me a T!

ALL- T!!

SANDI- Give me an H!

ALL- H!!

SANDI- Give me an E!

ALL- E!!

SANDI- Give me a W!
ALL- W!!
SANDI- Give me an O!
ALL- O!!
SANDI- Give me an R!
ALL- R!!
SANDI- Give me an L!
ALL- L!!
SANDI- Give me a D!
ALL- D!!
SANDI- What's that spell?
ALL- The World!!
SANDI- What's do we want?
ALL- The World!!
SANDI- When do we want it?
ALL- Right now!!

(The cheerleaders exit.)

NARR- Yes, everything was set for the big night. Thanks to a tip from the Supreme Diva, the mayor arranged for extra security as she stepped out to go to the school football game. Unfortunately, due to the mayor not being very smart, she did not pick the best protection.

SCENE SIX

(Morbidman and Everyman enter, playing like secret service agents.)

EVERYMAN- All clear!

(Sallie and Master of the Obvious enters.)

MORBIDMAN- The school looks safe, Madam Mayor. Looks like you'll be able to enjoy the game in peace.

SALLIE- I sure hope so.

EVERYMAN- Nothing to worry about, Mayor. Just relax, and have an evil scheme.

SALLIE- A what?

MASTER- It's teenage slang for having a good time.

SALLIE- Oh right. I should remember that. Need to look hip for the kids, you know.

(Mandi enters.)

EVERYMAN- Intruder at ten o'clock!!

MORBIDMAN- Halt! Stay where you are. Prepare to be searched!

MANDI- Me? But I'm just a sweet cheerleader.

EVERYMAN- Right, and I'm a snow cone salesman.

SALLIE- Oh come on, Morbidman, let her through.
MORBIDMAN- Madam Mayor, as head of security--
SALLIE- She's a cheerleader. How harmful could she be?
EVERYMAN- Ehh, she's right.
MANDI- Hi, Ms. Mayor, ma'am. I'm Mandi. Welcome to Terminus Central High School.
SALLIE- Thank you, Mandi.
MANDI- I was wondering if you would like to buy a candy bar.
SALLIE- Candy?
MANDI- It's a fund raiser. For the squad.
SALLIE- Oh, none for me. But perhaps my security detail would like some?
MANDI- Sure. In fact, how about free samples?
MASTER- That means free chocolate!
EVERYMAN- Sure thing, kid!
MORBIDMAN- Pass the candy, Mandi.

(Mandi hands each of the guys a chocolate bar.)

MANDI- Eat up, boys.
EVERYMAN- Mmmm, it's so tasty.
MORBIDMAN- There's a special ingredient. My morbid senses can tell.
MANDI- You be there is.
EVERYMAN- Is it coconut?
MANDI- Nope.
MORBIDMAN- Pistachio?
MANDI- No.
MASTER- I know, it's chloroform.

(Morbidman, Everyman, and Master of the Obvious all faint.)

SALLIE- What happened?
MANDI- Red! Black! Attack!

(The other cheerleaders leap out, along with Dr. Insidious.)

SALLIE- Dr. Insidious!
DR. I- Hello, Mayor. Surprised to see me?
SALLIE- *(snickering)* You're a cheerleading coach? What a dork.
DR. I- Stop laughing.

(Sallie laughs harder.)

DR. I- Look, this is serious. I'm trying to take over the world here... Can you stop?
SALLIE- I'm sorry.
DR. I- Now, are you going to sign over control of the city to me? Or will I turn the girls loose on you?
SALLIE- I can't do that, Dr. Insidious.

DR. I- Very well. Ladies, it's time to--

(Kathy enters with a tray of cookies.)

KATHY- Hello, girls!

ANDI- Hey look! It's Kathy.

KATHY- I just wanted to bring you some of my super cheerful chocolate chip cookies
for your first attempt at taking over the world.

MANDI- Wow, you are so awesome!

(The cheerleaders swarm around the cookie tray to take samples.)

DR. I- Kathy, my dear, how many times have I told you, no snacks while I am working!

KATHY- Oh, poo, how often do the girls get to take over the world?

ANDI- Mmmm, these are so good!

DR. I- Ladies? The mayor, the world, let's stay on task as we eat.

SANDI- Right-o, Dr. I. Girls? Let's convince the mayor why she should surrender.

(The Diva enters.)

DIVA- No so fast, girls!

DR. I- No! Not you! Not the Supreme Diva!

DIVA- Yes, it's me.

DR. I- How did you know?

DIVA- Next time you cut someone from the squad, make sure they're not one of your
arch-enemies!

SANDI- Christina? Is that you?

DIVA- Yes, it's me.

MANDI- Oh my goodness! You're the Supreme Diva?

DIVA- Uh huh.

BRANDI- That's pretty cool.

KATHY- No wonder you're so good at the quadruple round off leap and mid air split!

DIVA- Girls, what are you doing? This isn't what we joined cheerleading for. Taking
over the world?

CANDI- Why not? You think we can't run the world?

DIVA- I'm sure you can. But is this the way you want to achieve it? Helping a madman
like Dr. Insidious, just so you can stay popular and be cheerleaders?

MANDI- Well, he did get us these way cool uniforms.

DIVA- Mandi, look what's happened. In one short play, Dr. Insidious has torn apart our
friendship and turned you all to evil. That's just not right.

ANDI- Maybe we like things the way they are?

DIVA- Do you? Sandi, remember the time in seventh grade when you tossed your
retainer out with your lunch? Who helped you find it?

SANDI- You did.

DIVA- Candi, who helped you memorize the states and capitals with a song?

CANDI- Only you, Christina.

DIVA- Andi, who stood up with you in seventh grade when you refused to dissect that frog?

ANDI- We both got F's on that one, but you stood by my side.

DIVA- Brandi, Mandi, remember the lip sync contest at church? When we won first prize?

MANDI- How can I forget? We sang "Welcome to the Jungle."

DIVA- No one could do Axl Rose like you, Brandi.

BRANDI- Yeah, well, you made a good Slash.

DIVA- We're friends, whether I'm on the squad or not. And as your friend, I have to put my foot down. Taking over the world is wrong. And even if I lose you all as friends, I'm not going to let you do it.

SANDI- You're right, Christina. Friends first.

DR. I- Traitor! You're off the squad!

MANDI- If you kick her off, you kick me off. Christina's my friend. And I'm not going to be evil either.

BRANDI- Me either.

ANDI- I'm with you, Christina! I mean, Miss Diva.

DR. I- Well, Candi, it's you and me. Destroy them.

CANDI- No way, psycho. I can't destroy my best friends.

(The girls all hug and say "I love you's" to each other.)

KATHY- That's my team! *(wipes a tear)* What spirit.

DR. I- Thwarted again!! And all by a stupid teenager.

MANDI- Oh don't feel bad, Dr. Insidious. We had fun.

CANDI- Yeah, we had an evil scheme while it lasted.

DR. I- Whatever. I guess I'm finished as a cheerleading coach.

BRANDI- Wait. Before you go... we all chipped in to get you something.

(Brandi hands him a present. He opens it, and it's a keychain with a mini-globe attached.)

MORBIDMAN- Really?

SALLIE- You guys are so worthless. I'm going to go watch the game. You coming?

(Sallie exits. Everyman and Master of the Obvious stand. Morbidman picks up the chocolate bar.)

MORBIDMAN- Oh look, chocolate.

(He takes a bite, and passes out. Everyman and Master of the Obvious exit.)

NARR- So the world was saved once again, and not just the world, but friendship. The Supreme Diva and her friends had learned two things in the whole matter: that friendship, and doing the right thing were more important than popularity. Dr. Insidious quit as the coach to stay home with Kathy, though they never missed a game or a cheerleading competition. And the girls had a great season, thanks to their new coach.

(The cheerleaders including Christina.)

SCORN- All right, girls, let's hear that new cheer.

GIRLS- Two bits, four bits, six bits a dollar!

If you think all guys are jerks, stand up and holler!!

SCORN- I'm so proud.

(The girls and Scorn exit.)

NARR- And as for Morbidman, he'll be okay. He only has a few bites left.

(Morbidman enters, sees the candy bar.)

MORBIDMAN- Cool! Chocolate!

(Morbidman eats the chocolate, and passes out again.)

NARR- The end!
